PROPOSAL TO INCREASE MILLAGE LIMITATION TO FINANCE PLANNING AND ZONING IN JOYFIELD TOWNSHIP

Shall Joyfield Township impose an increase of up to 1.5 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 3 years, 2011 through 2013 inclusive, solely to be used for funding of planning and zoning activities within the township, which 1.5 mill increase will raise an estimated \$38,874 in the first year the millage is levied?

DISTRICT LIBRARY REPLACEMENT MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Blaine and Crystal Lake Townships, City of Frankfort

Shall the Benzie Shores District Library, County of Benzie, Michigan, levy an amount not to exceed .75 mill (\$.75 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable real and tangible personal property within the Benzie Shores District Library District in perpetuity beginning in the year 2012, for the purpose of providing funds for all District Library purposes authorized by law; and shall the District Library levy such new additional millage for said purpose? The estimate of the revenue the District Library will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Library in the 2012 calendar year is approximately \$261,000.
