Jail Operations Millage Renewal

For the purpose of renewing and continuing funding for County Jail Operations at the same millage level as previously approved by the voters in 2009, shall the previously approved millage above the Constitutional tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within the County of Benzie be continued and renewed by up to 0.9000 of one (1) mill (\$.90 per \$1,000 of Taxable Value) for a period of six (6) years (2015-2020) inclusive.

If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$1,007,983.70 in the first year of levy for the County Jail Operations.

Public Transportation System Millage Renewal

For the purpose of renewing and continuing funding for the Benzie Transportation Authority in Benzie County at the same millage level approved by the voters in 2006 and 2011, shall the previously approved millage above the Constitutional tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within the County of Benzie be continued and renewed by up to 0.5000 of one (1) mill (\$.50 per \$1,000 of Taxable Value) for a period of five (5) years (2016-2020) inclusive?

If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$559,843.63 for County public transportation services in the first calendar year of the levy.

Almira Township

Proposal to Renew Recreation Millage

This proposal will permit the Township to renew the .275 mills for the purpose of providing funds for improvements, maintenance, operations, and developments at all township recreational facilities previously approved by the electors and which will expire after the December 2015 levy. The .275 mills will be subject to Headlee roll backs.

Shall the previously voted tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Almira Township, of .275 mills, (\$.275 per \$1000 taxable value) be renewed for a period of four (4) years, 2016 through 2019 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for improvements, maintenance, operations, and developments at all township recreational facilities, and shall the Township levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$37,720 in the first year the millage is levied.
