



Benzie County residents have a 24 / 7 drop off program which allows them to recycle #1 through #7 plastics, clear and colored glass bottles & jars, paper & cardboard, tin & aluminum containers. They realize the savings achieved by recycling, not only to the environment, but to their pocket books by reducing trash disposal costs. The 24 / 7 Residential Recycling Program is funded by an annual surcharge imposed on households. Businesses are not charged and do not pay this annual surcharge.

Benzie County Businesses are invited to subscribe to the current 24 / 7 Residential Recycling Program by paying a yearly fee and obtaining a permit allowing use of the drop off recycling bins. The fee will be determined by the recycling needs of the business. Subscription services are based on the term of one year. Subscription fees are evaluated each year by the Benzie County Solid Waste Advisory Committee. You may always recycle cardboard at school trailers at no charge through the Cardboard Recycling Program offered by Packaging Corp. of America.
